2015 Salmon River Cooperative Spring Dive Population Survey**

This year the dive had an interruption in the form of a thick sediment slug from the upper reaches of the North Fork down to the Main Stem. If you already registered for the 8th & 9th, we have your info but please register your desire to dive on the 23 & 24th. Divers are required to register, particularly individuals who would like to be crew leaders. A downloadable registration form and schedule is available the SRRC website:

You can also register with Tom Hotaling of the SRRC at fisheries@srrc.org or by phone at (530) 462-4665 by July 20th. Your response is very important for planning and logistical purposes. If you are registering as a large group, please provide a head count and list of participants.

There will be a maximum of 80 divers. This ceiling is important as it allows sufficient people to cover all reaches while minimizing the impact. Non-divers are encouraged to participate – help is always needed at the check-in/check-out tables, to shuttle people and gear, and to assist in other logistical activities.

SRRC is asking for a donation of \$5 from participants to go directly towards supporting this event. The fee can be paid online at the SRRC website when you register, or upon check-in at the dive.

Lunch and Gear: All divers are responsible for bringing their own lunch and are encouraged to bring dive gear. The SRRC and the KNF will have a limited supply of gear available for use by volunteers.

If you are a first or tenth year volunteer, training for White Water Safety and Fish Identification is mandatory for all non-state/non-federal employees and volunteers. It is mandatory for people participating for the first time.

What to Bring

- Wetsuits, Felt Bottoms, Mask, Swim suits and trunks for under the wetsuit plus a set of dry clothes to change into.
- If you plan to camp, bring your own camping needs. Free Camping is available at Nordheimer Campground.
- Lunch food.
- To reduce waste, please bring your own eating utensils to dinner and breakfast.
- For diving, daypacks preferably mesh or dry, but any pack will do to keep your lunch and any other items you may need throughout the day. Bring your own waterproof lunches and water bottles.
- Waterproof sunscreen, sunglasses, hats, camera...
