*Chinook juveniles reported in many places; appear to be healthy and decent numbers, although may be stressed in places due to warm water.

**Debris flow on SF Salmon River due to slides in Blind Horse Creek occurred on 8/2/22 following heavy rain from thunderstorms over the 2021 River Complex area. Taylor Creek drainage also contributed substantial turbid water and fine sediment to East Fork and South Fork; and dark water was observed the entirety of mainstem Salmon River. Fish mortality was reported and likely included adult Spring Chinook.
