[^]The survey on 7/25 reported 88 Spring Chinook (84 adults; 4 jacks) near the mouth of the Salmon River. Given the anomalous nature of the report, the location was rechecked on 7/26 or 7/27. The experienced individual who performed the resurvey only found American Shad; and it was recommended by the CDFW co-lead for the lower Salmon River effort to remove the 88 "Chinook" due to mis-identification.

*SF Salmon River (and mainstem Salmon River) demonstrates an elevated amount of sand and finer material, including significant infilling of large pools. These observations are in result of (1) slides/debris flows in August 2022 following heavy rain over the 2021 River Complex area; and (2) general erosion and additional landslides in the same fire footprint during a spring run-off that included a higher-than-normal snowpack. Turbidity became notably elevated below certain tributaries: Little Grizzly Ck, Rush Creek, and Taylor Creek (EF Salmon).

**SF Salmon River, especially upstream of Cecilville, reported observations of elevated wood loading as a result of aforementioned debris flows.

***Two live Pacific lamprey adults and 1 lamprey redd found. All observations were made in differing reaches.
