**Basics:**

- Approximately 20-30 hrs/week mid May-September
- Part-time, Temporary, Seasonal Position
- Reports to: SRRC Noxious Weeds Project Coordinator
- Starting Pay Rate: \$18 - \$21/hr DOE
- Location: Sawyers Bar, California (applicant should be willing to reside within commuting distance – Salmon River, Scott Valley, Mid Klamath)

**General Responsibilities:**

- Participate in surveys and non-chemical treatments of noxious weed species (treatment methods include digging, pulling, weed whacking, etc.)
- Participate in native plant material collection, propagation, and planting.
- Summarize and track biological and habitat data on field forms and electronic devices.
- Training will be provided.
- Camping and/or backpacking in remote wilderness conditions may be required.
- Potential for participation in meadows inventory and assessment.
- Potential for participation in processed based restoration.

**Required Qualifications:**

1. A valid driver's license and dependable transportation are required.
2. Good organizational skills and record keeping (attention to detail is critical).
3. Works well as part of a team and contributes to a safe work environment.
4. Ability to follow directions, with good oral and written communication skills.
5. Must have access to a reliable method of communication, either phone or email, that is checked often.
6. Ability to hike, bend, and kneel for extended periods of time and lift up to 30 pounds. Fieldwork involves navigating in steep terrain, over uneven ground, near and/or in swift water.
7. Willingness to work in inclement weather conditions and in remote areas.

**Preferred Skills & Qualifications:**

1. Familiarity with smart phone operation and/or Geographical Positioning Systems (GPS) skills preferred.
2. Experience identifying plant species, both native and non-native.
3. CPR/First Aid qualifications.
